ENGAGE WITH JABRA

Spend a lot of time on the phone working from home or at your business? Free your hands and multi task better with Jabra.

As you embrace mobile working, the freedom to move around is more important than ever.

And what about those workers who act as reception or helpdesk staff?

Danish firm Jabra has released its latest generation of workplace headsets available in mono (one earpiece), stereo (two earpieces) or convertible (single in-ear) form factor that Jabra says will address several major pain points.

Chief amongst these is the fact that phone calls are becoming more complex and you often need to access detailed information elsewhere to solve a customer issue.

The ability to solve complex problems over the phone can be essential to building a strong business relationship. But being packed into noisy, overcrowded offices can negatively effect on call quality, and it is also these problems that Jabra is now aiming to address.

You can now have many devices (calls

from mobiles and handsets) operational within an open-plan office with a great wireless range up to 100 metres.

The headsets now also offer battery life to last throughout the working day, with



Jabra promising 13 hours without needing a charge.

The new Engage hardware also contains a new two-way microphone set-up that the company says offers “unmatched” call quality, providing clearer, smoother audio with advanced noise-cancelling ability, using a microphone listening out for exterior noise and shutting that out.

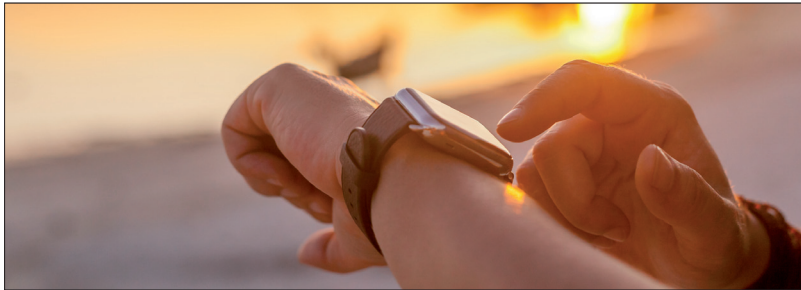
Up to five external devices can be linked to the Engage 75 range, allowing devices such as phones or laptops to be connected via Bluetooth, with up to two devices on the Engage 65 line.

“This is a significant step for us... this is probably the biggest undertaking for our company in the last ten years,” said Bjorn Ekner, Jabra’s senior director, solutions and alliances.

The Jabra Engage 75 Convertible can connect simultaneously to a desk phone, softphone, mobile phone and two Bluetooth devices and enables 3x more users in the same office space – with no loss in connection quality.

There’s nine hours of talk time, depending on usage and has a fast charge option delivering 40 per cent battery in just 30 minutes and this convertible headset comes with an ear hook in the box, a neckband and headband are available as accessories and weighs in at just 18g, making the Jabra the lightest call centric headset on the market.

TESTED
SMARTWATCHES

What's important in smartwatches now? Design, battery life, ease of use and price do matter. Jon Mamonski travels the world and after exhaustive road testing, reviews nineteen leading smart watches for ladies, gents, the fitness focused and fashionistas.

Let's start with the winners of each category.

★ **Best Ladies Fashion Smartwatch**

Three established brands battled it out with **Fossil** and **Kate Spade** as runners up while **Michael Kors Access Bradshaw** takes the prize and has the best price from \$359 to boot.

★ **Best Fitness Smartwatch**

Fitbit owned this market, but the monster brands are knocking on the door. Runner up is the **Fitbit Ionic** – a great fitness watch except for the \$359 street price. The **Samsung Gear Fit2 Pro** is equal to the task, but you pay \$209.

★ **Best Gender Free Smartwatch**

This highly competitive group saw the three giants – Apple, Fitbit and Samsung, slogging it out. In third place, the ever-popular **Apple Watch 3** (let down by its battery life), and second, **Samsung's Gear 2** – its closest rival. First place goes to a new Fitbit entrant, the **Versa** with a street price of \$249. Clever design, a fitness coach, great battery life and good value.

★ **Best Gents Fashion Smartwatch**

Hotly contested and with the biggest market of players, there's five stand outs and a clear winner. (**Garmin Fenix 5+**, **Huawei Watch 2**, **Samsung Gear 3**, **Mobvoi Ticwatch Pro** and **ASUS Zenwatch 3** as the runner up), each have their qualities but the winner, for sheer design brilliance, battery life and bang for the buck is the **Amazfit Pace**.

★ **Best Battery Life**

A standout winner here – the **Matrix PowerWatch** series that require no charging – you heard me right. Just strap it to your wrist and your body heat provides all the energy it needs. You never have to take it off.

★ **Best budget and most expensive**

At \$99 the **S928** is hard to beat and in the upper stratosphere, the **Breitling Exospace B55** weighs in at a mere \$8,999. The Breitling is aimed specifically at yachties with cash to splash or if you simply want bragging rights.

Google Drive

1 Google Drive has been one of the most advanced cloud storage services for years because it includes cloud computing. This means that if you need to make changes to a file live – in the cloud so each of your devices will always have access to the latest version of a file.



Google Photos

2 Regardless of the photo app in your phone, Google Photos is one of the best photo apps - period. The app will automatically back up your photos to the cloud, which means they can be accessed on any device. Factoring in the unlimited free storage and a powerful search feature that lets you find pictures that feature almost any subject, Google Photos is a must-have app.



Wunderlist

Flipboard

5 Flipboard is a news reader that you can personalise to bring you the kind of information you like.

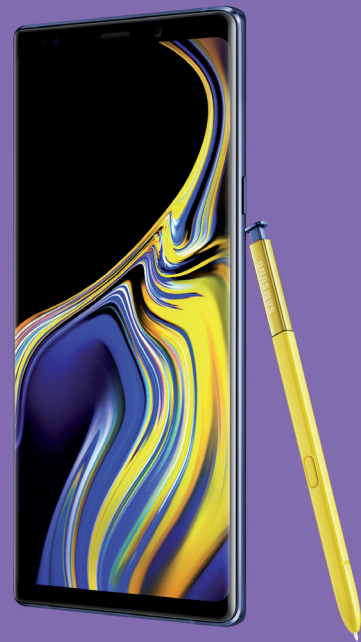

Install the Pocket browser extension for Chrome, Safari, or Firefox, then simply click the Pocket icon when you come across an interesting website or article. From there, open Pocket on your mobile device and you'll find all of the websites that you saved for later.



7 If using Google Earth doesn't already make you want to pack your suitcase, its new update just might. The refreshed version of Google's virtual travel app, recently rolled, includes a new Voyager feature for exploring curated digital journeys. One such voyage, called Land Art from Above, offers a bird's eye view of large-scale outdoor art installations, while Amazing Urban Gardens takes you from greenhouses in Singapore to sprawling forests in Italy. Google Earth's new knowledge cards also divulge details about points of interest around the globe.
